"Preserving our Waters" takes a look at the 50-year history of the Estero Bay Aquatic Preserve.



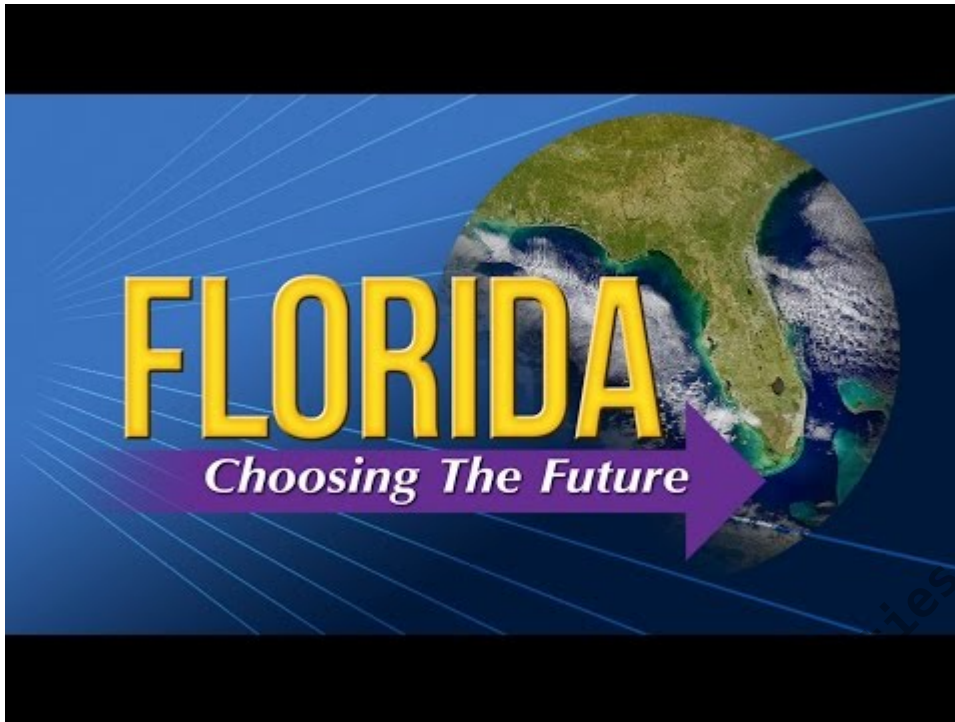
"In Their Own Words: Perseverance and Resilience in Two Florida Fishing Communities", tells the stories of commercial fishermen in Cedar Key and Cortez.



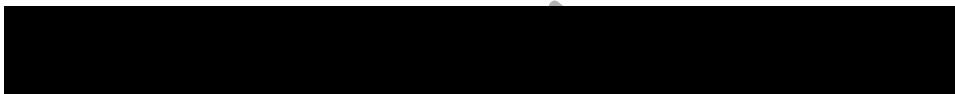
Watch the documentary “Veterans – The Telling Project,” produced with WEDU PBS. Premiered in Nov 2015.
