## Programs Offered:

Organizations can bring a speaker to their community with the following programs:

### Florida Talks

**Deadline:** Rolling until funds are expended

**Funding Amount:** \$500

**Who can apply:** Nonprofit organizations with an operating budget of \$500,000 or less

Florida Talks are single speaking engagements. Organizations can apply for funds to bring a speaker to their community as a component of other programs, or to celebrate a moment of cultural significance (Black History Month, Women's History Month, etc.). Applicants generally receive a response within two weeks of submitting an application.

**Deadline:** June 21, 2019

**Funding Amount:** Up to \$5000

**Who can apply:** All nonprofit organizations

Organizations hosting a Speaker Series will recruit and facilitate a series of four to six engaging talks with expert historians, storytellers, researchers, and authors. For the 2019-2020 season, all programs must occur between September 1, 2019 – May 30, 2020.
